Billy Slater is a talent unlike any other the modern game of Rugby League has seen.

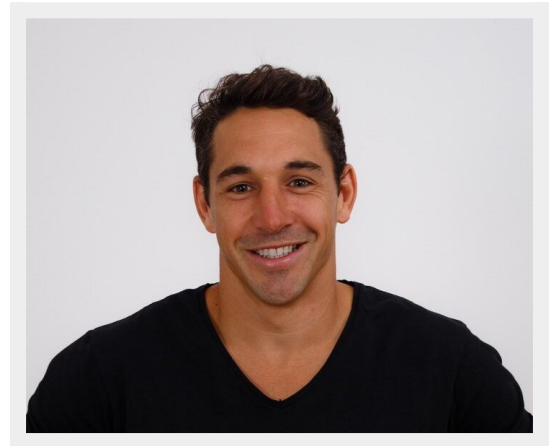
